


LIVING THE LANCER LIFE

ALUMNI CORNER





Later on, Chiara would establish a consulting firm in which she helped open new charter schools and fundraised nearly thirty million dollars.

As of August 1st, Chiara now works as the Executive Director for the Rhode Island League of Charter Schools. In this capacity, she supports both individual schools and the sector at large, while also interfacing with advocacy and policy at the legislative level and with the state department of education. At the same time, she is actively pursuing her Doctor of Education Leadership from the University of Pennsylvania.
