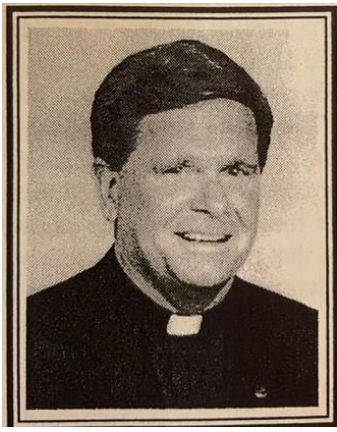


LIVING THE LANCER LIFE

Christopher worked as a public defender for seven years in New York City before moving to Massachusetts to begin private practice as a trial attorney, concentrating in criminal defense, divorce and civil rights. He also teaches civil rights and constitutional law at a number of Boston area colleges. As part of his mission to teach individual rights, he has given out over 10,000 pocket copies of the US Constitution and Bill of Rights, including 600 to Notre Dame!
