Notre Dame opened its doors to a sixteen year old Ukrainian refugee, who was granted an F-1 Visa to study in the U.S. This young man was separated from his parents, who remain in Ukraine fighting the war.

Our school has secured a family to house and care for this student who has been living in UN housing to this point. Arriving in the U.S. this week, this young man speaks fluent English and has a solid academic record. It is Notre Dame's privilege to support his journey for the next few years. We are reaching out to request monetary assistance to underwrite his significant tuition and living expenses, which total about \$20,000 a year.

Many of us are sympathetic to the Ukrainian crisis as we continue to learn of the unimaginable loss of life, livelihood and destruction occurring there.
