

He met via Zoom with our community to talk about this year's One Book, One Read summer book, *Finding Chika*, which he authored in 2019. Mr. Albom discussed his book and relationship with Chika, whom he and his wife brought to the US from Haiti for medical treatment. He also took a variety of questions from the students and faculty.
