



Zadravec Memorial Scholarship

Joe Zadravec was a member of the Notre Dame Class of 1997 who passed away at the age of 30 in 2009. Joe was an excellent pitcher and played for the Notre Dame varsity baseball team, as well as Fairfield American Legion and Norwalk Community College. In recognition of his family's appreciation for Notre Dame, and Fr. Bill, a scholarship has been set up in Joe's name.

This scholarship, in the amount of a \$1,000 award towards 2017-18 tuition, will be made to a current freshman, sophomore or junior.

The committee will consider:

- a) Applicant must play baseball at Notre Dame
- b) Family must have demonstrated financial need
