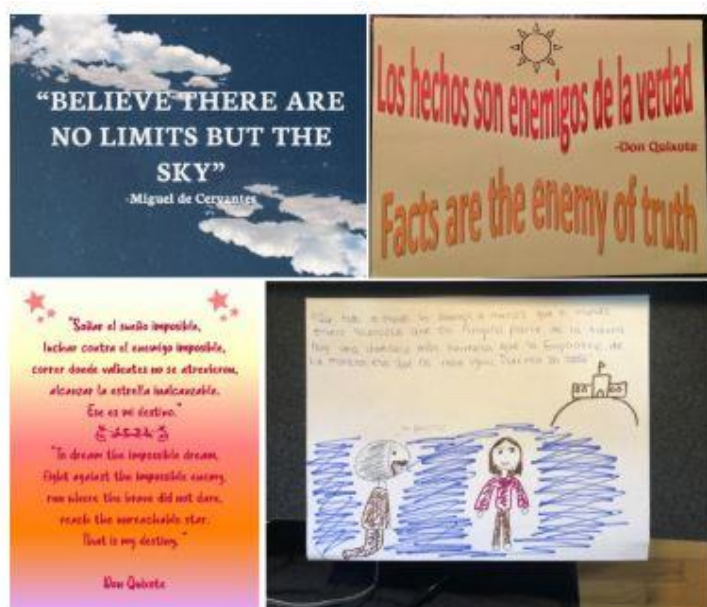


THE LATEST FROM THE CLASSROOM
