



Program Information

Leadership Summit typically meets the third Thursday of the month September 2024 through May 2025, 8:30am-4:30pm. Some dates may fluctuate with holidays and school breaks. Locations will vary, as the program is designed to expose participants to a variety of businesses and locations throughout Summit County.

Program Content:

All participants will complete a DiSC behavioral profile, and this will be used as a foundational component throughout the program. Sessions and content will vary over the nine months; but they will contain similar components:

- Reflection and Check-in: Participants break into small groups and discuss their utilization of knowledge and skills acquired through Leadership Summit. This provides opportunities to discuss real-life situations, gather feedback from peers, and create action plans for next steps.
- Guest Trainers: Leadership experts from different organizations and locations will facilitate content focused on contemporary leadership topics including Values-based Leadership, Conscious Leadership, Change Management, Situational Leadership, Building Effective Teams, etc. These sessions are interactive and activity based.
- Topical Panels: 3-4 local leaders join a panel to discuss critical issues in our community including Public Safety, Healthcare, Economic Development, Housing, Education, etc. *Typically, seven out of nine sessions have topical panels.*
