

Masking, Vaccination and Exposure Policy



New Masking Policy

Starting May 15th, Masking will be optional for all staff and participants at all campuses and for all activities (indoor and outdoor). *Social distancing is recommended, but not required.*

There are times you will still need to wear a mask at program...



New Exposure Procedure

If you spent time with someone who tests positive for COVID-19:

- You can continue to come to program as long as you feel well and **wear a mask around others for 10 days**

You must still report any COVID exposure to your DSP or Service Manager.

Test on day 5 (or sooner if you have symptoms):

- If you test negative, **continue to wear a mask at program until day 10**
- If you test positive, stay home for 5 days after your test

Vaccination Requirement

- No change in vaccination requirement
- Initial vaccination + 1 booster is still required for in-person services



COVID Symptoms / COVID Positive


No change in policy if you have COVID symptoms:

If you feel sick with COVID symptoms, test immediately.

No change in policy if you test positive for COVID-19:

Stay home for 5 days after your test. Please report positive COVID results to your Service Manager whether you provide in-person services or not. After 5 days, you can come back if you are feeling better.

If you test negative or are not sick with COVID, stay home while you feel unwell
