Rabbi Dr. Howard Markose

Rabbi Dr. Markose is excited to be joining CSFA for the High Holidays 5783 as rabbi and teacher. Rabbi Markose was born and raised in Minneapolis, Minnesota and studied Hebrew and Psychology at the University of Minnesota, earning his B.A. in 1979. He received his rabbinical ordination from the Jewish Theological Seminary of America, and with his wife, Dr. Judy Markose, moved to Toronto, Canada in 1984 to work with the Jewish community, where he served as rabbi at Adath Israel Congregation and Shaar Shalom over a ten-year period. In 1994, Rabbi Markose and Judy, along with their three sons, realized their dream of moving to Jerusalem, Israel. Rabbi Markose is currently a teacher of Bible at the Pardes Institute of Jewish Studies in Jerusalem, The Jewish Theological Seminary of America, and the Hebrew Union College. He also conducts Bar/Bat Mitzvah ceremonies for families visiting from North America. Rabbi Markose has a PhD in Bible from Bar Ilan University, Israel on the topic: Metaphor in the Book of Numbers. The Rabbi and Judy live in Jerusalem, as do their three sons and daughter (Israeli born!), and they are blessed with four grandchildren and one more on the way.



Hazzan Sarah King

A vital and central part of our synagogue life, Sarah King has served the CSFA community as Hazzan since 2014, when she was a student at Stern College for Women of Yeshiva University. Sarah hails from Baltimore, Maryland, where she attended the Bais Yaakov School. Growing up at Beth El Congregation, where her father is the Hazzan, she served as Bnei Mitzvah tutor, Torah reader, and led the interactive family High Holiday services. In addition to her synagogue career, Sarah is also a harpist and singer, having been involved in past performances with the High Desert Opera Company in Grand Junction Colorado, including *The Mikado*, *The Barber of Seville*, and *The Elixir of Love*. A graduate of the Cardozo Law School, Sarah made aliyah in the winter of 2022 and currently resides in Jerusalem. She is making a special trip back to the United States for the High Holidays to celebrate with her CSFA community.
