## *HCCW Street Team Overview*

---

The Hispanic Chamber of Commerce of Wisconsin (HCCW) Street Team is a Limited Term of Employment position.

As a Street Team Ambassador you will join a group of local and diverse community ambassadors who connect low and moderate income families living in Dane County with the HCCW's wide range of programming.

The HCCW Street Team Ambassadors (STA) actively promote the HCCW's mission and connect local residents to one another and to appropriate programs. The STA's utilize their knowledge of the local community to enable the creation of a holistic outreach plan to notify the residents of HCCW programs and to promote awareness of the HCCW's mission through community events, flyer distribution, presentations, resource fair participation and relational interactions.

## *HCCW Street Team Ambassador Mission and Expectations*

The STA's primary focus will be to assist the Senior Regional Director and Madison office in achieving the HCCW's mission. The STA's are expected to gain a new understanding of the low-and-moderate income (LMI) populations and participate in direct ongoing programming to assist the LMI toward upward economic mobility.

This position will have a high level of social interaction and a strong community outreach component. As a STA member you will have the chance to interact with HCCW members and partners.

The base rate is \$12 an hour for a limited term employment position. Additional bonus compensations are available depending on performance and programs development locally, regionally, and statewide.
