## **Remember!**

- Maintain at least 6 feet between yourself and other customers.
- Wash your hands or use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Cover coughs and sneezes.

## **Fuel Dispenser Use Instructions**

1. Remove nozzle from dispenser.
2. Place in vehicle.
3. Select fuel type.
4. Lift activation nozzle.
5. Pull the trigger on the nozzle to begin the transfer.
6. When finished, turn off pump.
7. Return the nozzle to its hanger or cradle.

### **In case of fire, spill, or release:**

- A. Use emergency pump shut off.
- B. Call 911 to report the incident.

## ***Safety Information for Dispensing Fuel***

1. Turn off engine.
2. No smoking.
3. Discharge static electricity by touching a metal service away from the nozzle.
4. Identify the location of the nearest fire extinguisher.
5. Identify the location of the Emergency Fuel Shut Off Switch.
6. Only fill approved containers meeting National Fire Protection Assoc. standards.
7. **Do Not** fill containers in your vehicle, place them on the ground.
8. **Do Not** use latch open devices while filling containers
9. Remain outside of your vehicle staying near the dispensing nozzle, keeping it in full view.
10. **Do Not** top off the tank.
