The Citygate Story

In October of 2007, Eric and Kim Petree became the pastors of what was then called Towne Worship Center, that had previously been pastored by Eric's father for 40 years.

From the beginning, Citygate has been focused on creating a place for people to touch God, connect to a family, and become fully engaged followers of Christ.

The life-giving message of the Gospel, passion and joy of our corporate worship experiences, and creative style of Citygate brought immediate growth. The church grew from 70 to 300 people in weekly attendance during their first three years, and over 100 people committed their lives to Christ. In the summer of 2010, the vision of a "church that looks like heaven," became a reality and growth increased rapidly. In February 2014, we outgrew the facilities we owned and became mobile. In June 2018, God opened a door for Citygate to have a campus in Lebanon, Ohio.

Today, nearly three thousand people call Citygate Church their home. We invite you to see for yourself how exciting church can be when people from different cultures, generations, and backgrounds come together as one to lift up Jesus with passion and purpose. Our Cities Can Be Won!!

2. Find Freedom

How Citygate Weekend Experiences Connect People to Christ:

We consider reaching people who do not follow Jesus Christ personally to be one of our greatest responsibilities. Our weekend experiences are for people at all stages in their spiritual journey but are primarily designed to reach those who have not yet decided to follow Jesus Christ.

Our Corporate Worship Experiences focus on four goals:

1. Celebration

- We believe church should be fun
- Every Sunday is Super Bowl Sunday

2. An Encounter

- Our Mission - To create a place, where people can touch God, **encounter** Jesus Christ and be radically changed and empowered by the Holy Spirit.
- We believe church is the place where people encounter God's presence

"His intent was that now, through the church, the manifold wisdom of God should be made known." **EPHESIANS 3:10**

3. Simple, Sticky and significant

- We believe church is the place where people learn how to apply God's truth to their daily lives.
- We believe the message should impact you beyond the service.

Paul wrote, "my preaching was not with enticing and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the spirit's power." **1 CORINTHIANS 2:4**

4. Salvation

- We believe offering salvation is our main purpose and God's heart.

"Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.' But how can they call on Him to save them unless they believe in Him? And how can they believe in Him if they have never heard about Him? And how can they hear about Him unless someone tells them?" **ROMANS 10:13-14**

FIND FREEDOM

Life change happens in the context of relationships. God created us to live in community with others, and it is only then that we can experience the full life He intends for us.

Citygate Groups have one simple purpose: **to bring people together.**

Citygate Groups provide three things:

1. A place to Connect with others.

"Yes, whatever a person is like, I try to find common ground with him so he will let me tell him about Christ and let Christ save him." **1 CORINTHIANS 9:22**

We were not made to do life alone. God created us for community, and Citygate Groups provide a place for you to connect with others, share life, and grow in faith together.

2. A place to Protect each other.

"We know what real love is because Jesus gave up His life for us. So we also ought to give up our lives for our brothers and sisters." **1 JOHN 3:16**

When we do life together, our problems become smaller as God uses others to bring support and encouragement to our lives. Citygate Groups become a place where others don't just know your name but care about what is happening in your life and want to support you in your spiritual journey.

3. A place to Grow together.

"As iron sharpens iron, so one person sharpens another." **PROVERBS 27:17**

We believe every person is created with God-given potential to make a difference in the world. Citygate Groups are a place you can grow with others to become more like Jesus and reach the potential God has put inside you.

Citygate Groups Model

We base our Citygate Groups model on the early church. As described in the book of Acts, small group meetings in homes helped lay the foundation for tremendous growth in the first church in Jerusalem.

"Day after day, in the temple courts and from house to house, they never stopped teaching and proclaiming the good news that Jesus is the Messiah." **ACTS 5:42**

"You know that I have not hesitated to preach anything that would be helpful to you but have taught you publicly and from house to house." **ACTS 20:20**

Citygate is a church of Connect Groups, not a church with Connect Groups.

Four things to know about Citygate Groups:

1. Our groups are "free market."

Citygate Growth Track was designed to help you find your WHY

1. **stepONE**: Connect to Christ (Follow Jesus)

Explore the ministry of Citygate and find out how to connect with our church. Step One takes place the FIRST weekend of every month.

2. **stepTWO**: Servant Leadership (Race for Third)

Find out what it means to be a leader at Citygate Church and learn how you can strengthen your character and gifting to fulfill your leadership potential. Step TWO takes place the SECOND weekend of every month.

3. **stepTHREE**: Connect to Cause (Discover Your Why)

4. **stepFOUR**: Connect to Community (Make a Difference)

CITYGATE CHURCH GOVERNMENT

As you consider investing your heart, time, family, and finances into the life of a church, it is important for you to feel confident in church leadership. Our goal in sharing the details of Citygate's government is that you will understand that our church is structured to support the values of integrity, accountability, and spiritual authority.

Our church government is made up of four groups of leaders:

1. Guided by **Pastor** _____ & **Staff** _____

The Pastoral Staff team is led by Pastor Eric. This team oversees the day-to-day ministry and operations of the church. These staff members serve the congregation and are responsible for the development of the spiritual life of the church.

2. Protected by **Board of Trustees** _____

Our Board of Trustees are members of the congregation appointed by the Senior Pastor to oversee the finances and direct the provision of the facilities needed by the church. They provide counsel to the Senior Pastor regarding the major financial commitments of the church.

3. Strengthened by **Care Pastors** _____

The Care Pastors are mature believers in Christ that provide spiritual protection to the church. They are Shepherds of the flock and provide spiritual guidance, counsel and leadership. They also oversee and lead our care teams.

4. Covered by _____ **Overseers** _____

Pastor Eric and Kim are personally submitted to the spiritual guidance and covering of this group. They may be called upon to help in accountability matters relating to the Senior Pastor if requested to do so by the Board of Directors. The Overseers serve as Apostolic Elders.
