Name of Bill: An Act Concerning Clean Curb Act of 2025

Sponsors: Olson

Bill Type: Council Bill

Status: On February 18, 2025, the bill was presented in the full County Council and referred to the Transportation, Infrastructure, Energy and Environment Committee.

Bill Overview: This bill will provide that it is unlawful for the use of any County road, street, highway, or public right of way by leaving cones and objects thereon; authorizing certain County agencies to remove cones and other objects on any County road, street, highway, or public right of way; providing for a certain exclusion; and generally relating to the prohibition on leaving cones and other objects on any County road, street, highway, or public right of way.

Rationale for the Bill: The objective of CB-015-2025 is to state that it is unlawful for the use of any County Road, street, highway, or public right of way by a leaving cone.

Impact to D4: This bill will affect District 4 and the overall County, in terms of providing that it is unlawful for the use of any County Road, street, highway, or public right of way by leaving cones and objects thereon. The bill authorizes certain County agencies to remove cones and other objects on any County Road, street, highway, or public right of way. It excludes official government use and public utility use.
