Name of Bill: An Act Concerning the Revised Elderly Property Tax Credit

Sponsors: Burroughs

Bill Type: Council Bill

Status: On February 4, 2025, the bill was presented in the full County Council and referred to Government Operation and Fiscal Policy Committee.

Bill Overview: This bill will revise the current elderly property tax credit to make its applicability exclusive of and separate and distinct from the Homestead and Maryland Homeowner's Property Tax Credit and changing the yearly thresholds for eligibility as well as addressing any hardships resulting thereof.

Rationale for the Bill: The objective of CB-009-2025 is to revise the elderly property tax credit to change the yearly thresholds for eligibility and address any hardships occurring as a result of said change.

Impact to D4: This bill will affect District 4 and the overall County, in terms of aiming to revise the elderly property tax credit system in Prince George's County, Maryland, making the credit exclusive and separate from the Homestead and Maryland Homeowner's Property Tax Credit and changing the yearly eligibility thresholds.
