Name of Bill: An Act Concerning Collective Bargaining Agreement International Association of Fire Fighters AFL-CIO Local 1619 (Fire Fighters, Paramedics, and Fire Fighter/Medics)

Sponsors: County Executive

Bill Type: Council Bill

Status: On February 18, 2025, the bill was presented in the full County Council and referred to the Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee.

Bill Overview: This bill will amend the labor agreement by and between Prince George's County, Maryland and the International Association of Fire Fighters, AFL-CIO, Local 1619 (Fire Fighters, Paramedics and Fire Fighter/Medics), to provide for wages and certain other terms and conditions of employment for personnel classifications initially certified by the Prince George's County Public Employee Relations Board or as amended by the Office of Human Resources Management.

Rationale for the Bill: The objective of CB-014-2025 is to amend the labor agreement by and between Prince George's County, Maryland and the International Association of Fire Fighters, AFL-CIO, Local 1619 (Fire Fighters, Paramedics and Fire Fighter/Medics).

Impact to D4: This bill will affect District 4 and the overall County, in terms of the Prince George's County, Maryland (the County) and the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 1619, AFL-CIO (Fire Fighters, Paramedics and Fire Fighter/Medics) have completed labor negotiations on a two-year labor agreement covering Fiscal Years 2025 and 2026. This Bill is to adopt and approve the referenced collective bargaining agreement in accordance with Section 16-233(f) of the Personnel Law.
