Name of Bill: An Act Concerning Watercraft Parked on County Roads

Sponsors: Olson

Bill Type: Council Bill

Status: On January 21, 2025, the bill was discussed in the full County Council and referred to the Committee of the Whole.

Bill Overview: This bill will prohibit the parking of watercraft on public streets, roads, highways, and rights of way within the County; to establish fines and penalties for parking a personally-owned watercraft on public streets, roads, highways, and rights of way in the County; to permit the towing and impounding of any personally-owned watercraft after a certain number of violations; and generally relating to the prohibition of parking a personally-owned watercraft on public streets, roads, highways, and rights-of-way in Prince George's County.

Rationale for the Bill: The objective of CB-002-2025 is to prohibit watercraft from being parked on public streets, roads, highways, and rights of way by issuing a fine to the owner for every twenty-four (24) hours the boat remains in violation.

Impact to D4: This bill will affect District 4 and the overall County, in terms of prohibiting abandoned watercraft from obstructing traffic or traffic site lines.
