Name of Bill: A Resolution Concerning Alcoholic Beverages – Licenses for Retail Grocery Establishments

Sponsors: Fisher, Blegay

Bill Type: Resolution

Status: On January 28, 2025, the resolution was introduced in the full County Council and referred to the Government Operation and Fiscal Policy Committee.

Bill Overview: This resolution would state a policy by the Prince George's County Council requesting that the Prince George's House and Senate delegations of the Maryland General Assembly support local legislation allowing the Board ("the Board") of License Commissioners for Prince George's County to issue a Class A beer and wine license to grocery establishments in the Board's jurisdiction to sell beer and wine to individuals who are twenty-one (21) years old or older.

Rationale for the Bill: The objective of CR-003-2025 is to issue a Class A beer and wine license to grocery establishments in the Board's jurisdiction to sell beer and wine to individuals who are twenty-one (21) years old or older.

Impact to D4: This resolution will affect District 4 and the overall County, in terms of establishing a process to sell wine and beer in grocery establishments.
