



Dear NYOS AP Community,

The exams in an Advanced Placement Course are an important part of participating in the AP program offered at NYOS. It is through the AP College Board exams in May of 2021, that students have the potential to earn college credit for these courses, thus saving both time and tuition in the future.

For the 2020-2021 academic year, a few changes have been made to AP College Board's timelines for registering for exams. As a result, **NYOS is asking that students register and pay for their AP exams by Friday, October 30, 2020.**

Students need to register for their exams online. Please take time to sit down with your student to ensure everyone is on the same page about which exams will be taken. To view and register for exams, students will need to log-on to their AP College Board account. For each exam the student wishes to take, they will need to select *Register for Exam*, and follow the prompts to sign up.

*The College Board fee amount is increasing by \$1 in 2020-2021.

*Reduced fee is based on free and reduced lunch qualifications. If you are uncertain, contact Norma Reyes: nreyes@nyos.org, for eligibility questions. Reduced fees now reflect the TX additional subsidy for AP testing that took effective as of 8/22/19.

** These fees apply to any changes to exams after November 15th. Exams cannot be ordered after March 13th.

NYOS is pleased to offer an online payment option to pay for AP exams. **If you are planning to make payment by 8/28, please use the following [link](#) to make payment.** *An updated link will be available once we transition to a new payment portal after 8/28. The new link will be shared on the NYOS website and the (NYOS) AP Central Google Classroom after 8/28.*

This link can also be accessed by navigating to <https://www.nyos.org/>. From the home page, navigate to *Secondary Student Resources*. There you will see a page for *AP Final Exam Schedule & Payment*. Though you need to pay for each exam, you only need to make one payment. So a student taking 2 Regular AP exams, and AP Research would need to pay \$333 ($\$95 + \$95 + \$143 = \333).

If you need financial assistance during this time, you may qualify for the free & reduced breakfast and lunch program, which significantly lowers the cost of AP exams!

Even if you think you may not qualify, we recommend that all NYOS families complete the [English or Spanish form found here](#) and email the finished form to our Food Services Manager, Maggie Mondragon-Munoz at mmondragon-munoz@nyos.org.

Families can submit this application anytime throughout the year, particularly if a parent/guardian becomes unemployed or if a families' household income drops below the income limit. **If the submitted form is approved by our Food Services Manager, you can select the free & reduced AP exam cost.**

Here is a timeline of registration and important dates:

- August 13th, 2020 begin registration for AP exams, and fees can be deposited
- October 30th 2020 NYOS AP Teachers finalize students taking exams
- **October 30, 2020 AP registration and fees due to NYOS**
- November 13th, 2020 AP College Board exam order date
- March 12th, 2021 Last day to order late exams (additional fees apply)
- May 3rd, 2021 Regular exam testing begins
