Dear NYOS Charter School Parents and Guardians:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you per state requirements of when STAAR testing results for the 2021-22 school year will be available to view online in the state of Texas Student Assessment Portal, which can be found at www.texasassessment.gov. Once you log in, you will be able to go online using a computer or smart device to access your child's scores the moment they become available. You will also be able to view your child's entire state testing history.

The schedule for release of 2021-22 STAAR Test Scores is as follows:

2022 May STAAR 3-8	June 24, 2022
2022 June EOC Retest (Alg, US, Bio, Eng 1, Eng II)	August 5, 2022

Use the table below to help you understand the following terms on the student score report.

Masters Grade Level	Passing Score	Means that your child is expected to succeed in the next grade level or course with little or no academic intervention. Formerly known as "advanced".
Meets Grade Level	Passing Score	Means that your child has a high likelihood of success in the next grade or course but may still need some short-term intervention.
Approaches Grade	Passing	Means that your child met the assessment requirements for

Level	Score	promotion and is considered to have met at least the minimum passing standard.
Does Not Meet Grade Level	Not a Passing Score	Means that your child did not meet the minimum passing standard for that assessment. Students at this level will need significant academic intervention.
