The speakers did an outstanding job. Mimi Marziani, from the Texas Civil Rights Project, spoke on voting and election laws. Alice Bufkin, with the Women's Healthcare Coalition of Texas, explained the current Women's Health Program and what we need to fight for and against in the Capitol. Jim Nelson, a lobbyist with Texas Association of School Boards, got members riled up about the importance of fighting vouchers.
