5. Please propose only one Q&A for each issue of Fig Tree Lit.
6. Make sure you have your first name, last name, and address to which you want us to send you copies of our books for free in the email if we select your Q&A to be published.
7. We will not share your email or address with any third parties.
8. If we select your Q&A to be published, you agree to our including (only) your name in an issue of Fig Tree Lit.
9. We will post your Q&A on our Twitter page, so if you have a Twitter handle, feel free to give it to us so that we can include it in our tweet.
