**Treasurer's Report**

- **The offerings received for General Pledge in March total \$12,607.00.**
- **We have received a total of \$19,192.04 in income in March.**
- **We have had a total of \$26,453.54 in disbursements for March.**
- **As of March 31, 2026, we have received \$59,035.67 in total income.**
- **As of March 31, 2026, we have had a total of \$26,453.54 in disbursements.**
- **The financial activity for the month of March produced a deficit in the amount of \$7,261.50.**
- **As of March 31, 2026, have a deficit of \$18,250.78.**

### **Senior Wardens' Reports**

  - **Budget: \$1,000, funded by the Roe Font Literary Association. Budget approval from Roe Font representative Mr. Whiteman**
  - **Darcel Arrington and Brenda Shepherd will be co-curators on collection of photos for panel display.**

### **Junior Wardens' Report**

- **Junior Wardens will manage all building contracts...ie snow removal, landscaping, etc. This frees the treasurer for core financial duties and aligns with the wardens' property oversight role.**
- **Security System: US Protective Service technician will inspect the main door's faulty contact sensor on Thursday.**
- **Bee Activity: Rick Moranz (bee removal) advised waiting until late June/July to assess if a nest forms.**
- **Maintenance Needs:**
  - **Boiler leak**
  - **Roof leak (causing women's restroom leak)**
  - **Deteriorated exterior wood mold**
  - **Damaged waste yard fence**
  - **Men's restroom repairs**
- **Clutter Removal: The Vestry will get bids to remove significant junk from the boiler room and other storage areas to improve access and space.**
