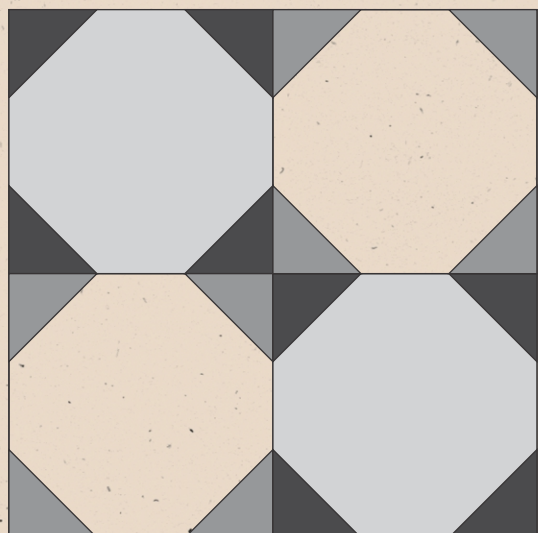




#7 2020 Block of the Week

Snowball



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Technique Tip:

To sew "diagonal squares"
attach the
"Sew Straight" or "Diagonal Seam Tape"
to your machine.

Fabric Requirements

Approx Fabric Sizes:

	Fabric #1: 5" x 10"
	Fabric #2: 5" x 10"
	Fabric #3: 5" x 8"
	Fabric #4: 5" x 8"

Cutting and Sewing Instructions

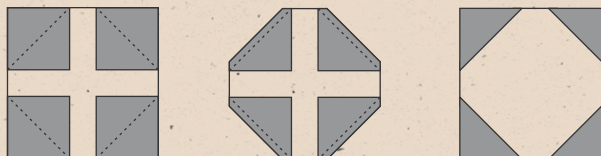
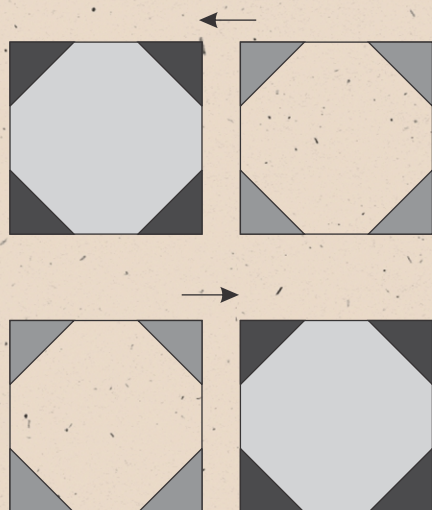
Accurate 1/4" seams are included in all measurements
to make an 8" block (7 1/2" finished).
Arrows indicate recommended pressing directions.

Cutting Instructions:

Fabric #1: cut 2 - 4 1/4" squares
Fabric #2: cut 2 - 4 1/4" squares
Fabric #3: cut 8 - 1 3/4" squares
Fabric #4: cut 8 - 1 3/4" squares

Sewing Instructions:

Place 4 small squares on the corners of a large square.
Sew diagonally. Trim the seam. Press. Make 4.



Layout and sew the pieced squares into 2 rows.

Sew the rows into a block.

Press well to finish the block.
