

Habitat Home Dedications

Two new Habitat for Humanity homes, built in part by St Paul's parishioners, will be dedicated on Sunday, December 16. Aaron and Andi Taylor's home will be dedicated at 1 PM, and at 2 PM Munawar and Rebecca Masih's home will be dedicated.

Both homes are at the Harmony Cottages subdivision, at the southeast corner of Harmony and Taft Hill Road, with the entrance off Harmony. The addresses for the homes are too new to be registered on Google Maps, but you can plug in the address for JJ's Gas Station (4005 S Taft Hill Road), which is caddy-corner to the development. Parking is available either at the Harmony Cottages development itself, or at the nearby Habitat ReStore (4001 S Taft Hill Rd).

At the dedication, the new occupants and their homes will receive blessings from the faith groups that built them, primarily FOCOLU, which is a group of four Ft Collins Lutheran churches that includes Trinity Lutheran Church. Each family will also receive hand-made quilts, furniture articles made by the FOCOLU youth, and staple foods for their pantry. If you would like to bring a non-perishable food item, it will be added to the pantries of each home. Please join us in these home dedications!
