



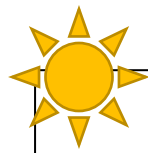

How to Register :

- Complete Registration Form & return to your child's teacher or school office.
- Class Availability is on a **First Come First Serve Basis.** There are maximum numbers per class.
- A confirmation will be sent home for each child.

Payment Information:

- Enclose a check made with your registration form made out to **SEASCS Learning Adventures** or cash.

Note: Payment must accompany your registration to secure class placement.

Class Confirmation:

- A confirmation of the classes your child **is enrolled in** for the current session will be sent home.
 - If he/she did not get into a class- it was full or cancelled. You will receive a refund for these classes.
 - **Important:** Mark the dates & times of the classes your child received a confirmation. This will be your only reminder.
- ✓ ***Send in a note the day of your child's class to their teacher stating that he/she is attending a Learning Adventure. Your child will not be able to stay without a note.***

Class Cancellations:

- Parents will be notified immediately if a class is cancelled for any reason.
- Please be sure to have day time and an alternate number in your contact information.
- If school is cancelled or dismissed early due to bad weather- there will be no Learning Adventure classes. We will make every attempt to reschedule any classes, however this is not always possible.
- Refunds: will only be issued if the class is cancelled or your child does not get into the class due to it being full.

Class Arrival and Pick-up:

- Students meet in the school lobby after the dismissal of school. Instructors will walk them to their class.
- Please pick up your child in the assigned classroom at the designated end of class.
- Parents **must sign out their child.** **Safety is our first priority.**

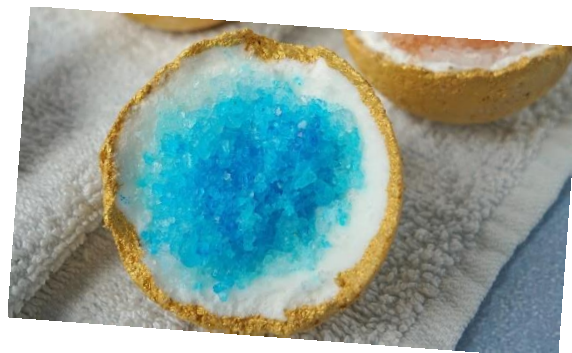
