Stand Up Placer is a 501c3 nonprofit agency dedicated to the mission "Saving lives by empowering survivors and educating communities to stand up to domestic violence, sexual assault, and human trafficking".

We were established in 1978 as a rape crisis hotline and domestic violence shelter. Over the years we have grown our services and grown our expertise in the areas of domestic violence, sexual assault and human trafficking. We were recently designated as one of ten agencies in California chosen to provide services for survivors of human trafficking; and in the first 3 months we provided services to more than 65 such survivors.

Our 55-bed Safe House provides an emergency shelter for those fleeing life threatening situations; a confidential 24/7 crisis line provides round the clock support to those seeking assistance; as the Rape Crisis Center for Placer County we are members of the Sexual Assault Response Team (SART) and provide support and advocacy to survivors of sexual assault; with therapy services, support groups, legal advocacy services, skills training, a drop-in center and a rapid re-housing program we provide a comprehensive suite of services to help survivors heal and build healthy new lives.
