



## Miami Beach United (MBU) Legislative Priorities

- Enhance Residents Quality of Life Through Zoning to Prevent Over Development, Measures to Reduce Traffic Congestion, and Ordinances/Enforcement to Combat Noise Pollution and Disruptive Behaviors.
  - Prioritize residential (not short-term) and small business development by eliminating current zoning incentives for hotel and office projects.
  - Require termination of alcohol sales at 2 am in all residential neighborhoods
  
- Ensure Good Governance by Promoting Transparency, Providing Residents with Timely and Complete Information on Issues Coming Before Governing Bodies, Allowing Adequate Opportunities for Residents to be Heard and Legislation to Promote Ethical Conduct by Elected Officials and City Staff.
  - Stricter adherence to “time certain” Commission agenda items
  - Initiate and support measures to enhance resident engagement.
  - Support Charter Review Board recommendations on Citizen’s Bill of Rights and ethical conduct by City officials.
  
- Protect Biscayne Bay, Beaches, Parks, and Streetscapes with Measures to Address Environmental Issues.
  
- Strengthen Measures that Preserve Historic Buildings and Neighborhoods.
  
- Implement Capital Projects to Better Protect the City from Storms and Sea Level Rise with Sensitivity to Residential and Business Impact.
