What is eProcurement?

The State of Vermont, through the Department of Buildings and General Services, is developing a new contracting tool to fundamentally change the way we do business. VTBuys, an innovative electronic procurement system, will significantly improve the way we procure products and services.

The new solution, once implemented, will become the primary platform for the State to perform sourcing (competitive solicitation), contracting, supplier management, and procurement activities. It also provides an online shopping platform for State users to purchase goods and services provided by our supplier partners.

Release 1 will include:

- Supplier portal.
- Sourcing (competitive solicitation) and bid management.
- Contract lifecycle management.

Release 2 will include:

- Catalog items for purchasing.
- Electronic purchase order submission, receipt generation and invoicing.
- Spend analytics and reports.

Key Features

P o	Supplier Management	An integrated portal that is a single point of entry for suppliers to do business with the State and provides access to all supplier-facing components.
P	Strategic Sourcing	Automated bidding process for both the State and suppliers for all types of solicitations, leveraging standard templates and libraries.
	Contract & Items	A single, central repository of all in-scope contracts. All contract processes are managed in one place, from negotiation, authoring, signature, and execution to renewal.
	Procurement	Catalog tied to contracts provides an online purchasing experience, with automatic purchase request and order processing.
	Invoicing	Electronic invoices can be generated by suppliers with visibility into invoice approval status.
[all	Purchasing Intelligence	Having all data in one place allows for robust data analytics and reporting to assess spend for more effective sourcing and contracting.
