The 10 producers who registered the most Angus beef cattle in the state of Kentucky recorded a total of 2,118 Angus with the American Angus Association[®] during fiscal year 2024, which ended Sept. 30, according to Mark McCully, the association's chief executive officer.

Angus breeders across the nation in 2024 registered 302,716 head of Angus cattle.
