

ΤΟ СΥΜΒΟΣΟΝ ΤΗΟ ΠΙΟΤΕΨΟ

Πιστεγω εἰς ἕνα Θεόν, Πατέρα Παντοκράτορα, ποιπτήν οὐρανοῦ καί Γῆς, ὁρατῶν τε πάντων καί ἀοράτων.

Καί εἰς ἕνα Κύριον Ἰπσοῦν Χριστόν, τόν Υἰόν τοῦ Θεοῦ τόν μονογενῆ, τόν ἐκ τοῦ Πατρός γεννηθέντα πρό πάντων τῶν αἰώνων. Φῶς ἐκ Φωτός, Θεόν ἀληθινόν ἐκ Θεοῦ ἀληθινοῦ, γεννηθέντα, οὐ ποιηθέντα, ὁμοούσιον τῷ Πατρί, δι' οὖ τά πάντα ἐγένετο.

THE CONFESSION OF FAITH
