Clifty Falls State Park
November 2021

Saturday, November 6

10am Nature Stroll - Explore Trail 10 on this easy 30-minute walk with the naturalist. Meet at the outdoor Pool.

2pm Wildlife of Clifty Falls - Discover what animals roam Clifty Falls State Park in the cover of darkness. We'll share footage captured from our trail cameras during this 30-minute program at the **Nature Center**. Watch unique animal interactions and find out how we can use this footage to better monitor and understand wildlife populations in the park.

Sunday, November 7

11am Meet our Turtles - Come to the **Nature Center** to meet some of our resident turtles. Discover the differences between our terrestrial box turtle and our aquatic turtles during this 30-minute program.

6-7pm Friends Group Meeting - Join our parks Friends Group! Meet us at the **Clifty Inn** to find out how you can become more involved in volunteering to better our park for current and future generations. Meet new people, while having the opportunity to learn and grow!
