She served as Deaf Mentor Program coordinator at the New Mexico School for the Deaf and the Arizona State Schools for the Deaf and the Blind for 10 years. She currently serves on the Joint Committee on Infant Hearing. She and her husband are the proud parents of two bilingual deaf teens who attend MSSD & KDES.
