

Geisha J. Williams is President, Electric, at Pacific Gas and Electric Company and member of the utility's board of directors.

Williams joined PG&E in 2007 and was named Executive Vice President for Electric Operations in 2011. Over the last six years under her leadership, PG&E customers have benefited from the best reliability in company history. Before PG&E, she held officer-level positions in customer service, marketing, external affairs and electric operations at Florida Power and Light Company.

A trustee of the California Academy of Sciences, Ms. Williams serves as board chair for the Center for Energy and Workforce Development, and as a director for the Association of Edison Illuminating Companies. She is also active in Executive Women in Energy and the University of Miami President's Council.

Ms. Williams' appointment is historical. She is the first Hispanic woman in America to hold the position of president of an electric utility company.
