

Steamboat Tennis and Pickleball Dog Policy - Guests

Dogs are welcome at STPC and make our lives better in so many ways. They can create a fun, happy environment and encourage interactions among people. Dogs also are a responsibility, and the opportunity to have them at the Steamboat Tennis and Pickleball Complex is a privilege all guests must respect. The policy below pertains to guests at STPC who bring their dogs to our Complex.

Requirements

- Dogs must be on a leash when inside the STPC premises. Dogs will not be allowed to roam free out of respect for other employees and guests that may not be fond of dogs.
- Dogs must be on a leash when on STPC outdoor walkways and turf areas.
- Dogs are not allowed on any court under any circumstances.

To participate, dogs must be:

- At least 3 months old.
- Up to date on vaccinations required by state law.
- Free of any communicable infections or any parasites such as fleas.
- Clean and well groomed.
- House-trained.
- Obedient, well-socialized and with no history of biting, excessive barking, chasing or aggressive behavior.

Pet Parent Responsibilities

To comply with our dog policy, dog parents who want to bring their dogs to our premises must agree to:

- Be 100% responsible for their dog's behavior, well-being, hygiene and happiness the entire time he or she is visiting.
- Ensure that their dog's behavior does not interfere with other employees' or guests' comfort or ability to work.
- Guests must provide their own dog items to ensure safety, such as leashes, crates or gates to keep the dog secure.
- Guests must provide their own pet wellness items, such as waste bags, toys, food and water bowls.

- Guests must clean up after their pet immediately if accidents occur.
- Be legally and financially responsible for any damage caused by their dog.
- Take their dog home at any time if the dog's behavior or health makes it a distraction, nuisance or danger to anyone else.
- Failure to abide by the Dog Policy will result in loss of pet privilege on STPC property.

Managing Issues

Concerns related to visiting dogs or the dog policy should be handled in the following way:

- Talk directly with the dog parent and work to resolve issues mutually.
- Escalate the issue to an STPC Management Staff Member (Leadership Team & Head Pros).
- Escalate the issue to the STPC Executive Director.

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
