Summary of HB 62: Capital Appropriations Bill

HB 62 holds the bond funding appropriations for the transportation and “vertical” (non-transportation) capital. The summary below does not include individual line item appropriations in the totals. You will notice that these numbers do not match up with the expected totals as a result. If you are looking for a specific project that may have received a line-item, it’s easiest to [search the bill](#) for that project.

Transportation

- \$9.3B to IDOT
- Approx. \$4.5B for transit projects
- \$2.5M for Asian Carp abatement at Brandon Road
- \$78M Grade Crossing Protection Fund
- \$400M CREATE
- \$98M for noise abatement at Chicago Belt Railway Yard
- \$700M for other rail projects (Quad Cities, Carbondale, Rockford passenger rail; Springfield Rail Improvement)
- \$29M for improvements to dams, spillways, and supporting facilities
- \$850M to I-80 expansion
- \$144M for airports
- \$150M for ports

Water Infrastructure

- \$100M from Water Revolving Fund for drinking water
- \$85M for sewage treatment works
- \$1.5M for nonpoint source water quality issues
- \$25M for green infrastructure to address water quality issues

Other

- Approx. \$700M to DCEO for grants to local governments, schools, and community-based providers for improving infrastructure
- \$400M to DCEO for broadband infrastructure
- \$50M to encourage commercialization of emerging technologies
- \$70M for electric vehicle charging and electrifying transit, fleets, and school buses
