FROM AHCA:

AHCA Summary of FY26 Skilled Nursing Facility Prospective Payment System Proposed Rule

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) issued the [proposed rule](#) for the skilled nursing facility (SNF) prospective payment system (PPS) fiscal year (FY) 2026 update.

In the FY26 NPRM, CMS has proposed a net market basket update of 2.8% - based on the proposed SNF market basket of 3.0%, plus a 0.6% market basket forecast error adjustment, and a negative 0.8% productivity adjustment. Of note, the proposed net market basket and underlying figures, below, all typically change between the proposed rule and the final rule based on more current data. Additionally, this is AHCA's preliminary analysis of the proposed rule. Additional information will be provided as AHCA continues its analysis of CMS' proposals.

The table below shows the components of the current proposed rule versus the last two year's final rules.

CMS states that the proposed net market basket update will increase Medicare SNF payments by approximately \$997 Million in FY26. SNF Value-Based Purchasing (VBP) reductions for certain SNFs subject to the net reduction in payments under the SNF VBP adjustments are estimated to total \$208.36 million in FY26.

For FY26, there are no geographic reclassifications because OMB has not published revisions since last year's rule. This stability in CBSAs eliminates the need to apply the 5% cap on decreases to a provider's wage index caused by a reclassification.

For comparison purposes, the final FY25 and proposed FY26 base rates following standard annual updates are shown in the payment provision highlights. The Forecast Error Adjustment is shown in the payment provision highlights.

SNF Provider Preview Reports – Now Available

The Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF) Provider Preview Reports have been updated and are now available. These reports contain provider performance scores for quality measures, which will be published on the [compare tool on Medicare.gov](#) and [Provider Data Catalog \(PDC\)](#) during the July 2025 refresh.

Data contained within the Provider Preview Reports are based on quality assessment data submitted by SNFs from Quarter 4, 2023 through Quarter 3, 2024. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) measures reflect Influenza Vaccination Coverage Among Healthcare Personnel measure data from Quarter 4, 2023 through Quarter 1, 2024, and COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage among Healthcare Personnel (HCP) measure data from Quarter 3, 2024. The claims-based measures reflect data from Quarter 4, 2021 through Quarter 3, 2023 and the SNF Healthcare-Associated Infections (HAI) measure data from Quarter 4, 2022 through Quarter 3, 2023.

Providers have until May 15, 2025, to review their performance data. Only updates/corrections to the underlying assessment data before the final data submission deadline will be reflected in the publicly reported data on [Medicare.gov](#). If a provider updates assessment data after the final data submission deadline, the updated data will only be reflected in the Facility-Level Quality Measure (QM) report and Patient-Level QM report. Updates submitted after the final data submission deadline will not be reflected in the Provider Preview Reports or on [Medicare.gov](#). However, providers can request a CMS review of their data during the preview period if they believe the displayed quality measure scores within their Provider Preview Reports are inaccurate.

For those users experiencing issues locating their agency's SNF Provider Preview Report, follow the steps outlined below:

1. Log into [iQIES](#) using your Health Care Quality Information Systems (HCQIS) Access Roles and Profile (HARP) user ID and password. (If you do not have a HARP account, you may register for a [HARP ID](#).)
2. From the Reports menu, select My Reports.
3. From the My Reports page, locate the SNF Provider Preview Reports folder. Select the SNF Provider Preview Reports link to open the folder.
4. Displayed for you is a list of reports available for download. The reports or files are listed in descending order and the newest files are displayed at the top of the list.
5. Select the desired SNF Provider Preview Report name link and the report will display.

New users will automatically receive the latest Provider Preview Report in their SNF Provider Preview Report folder once their new iQIES user role is approved. Follow the steps above to locate your agency's report in the SNF Provider Preview Report folder.

Regulatory Relief:

SNF Off-Cycle Provider Enrollment Reporting Delayed Until August 1st

I am pleased to report that CMS has notified AHCA/NCAL that the mandatory off-cycle SNF provider enrollment revalidation deadline has been pushed back to August 1, 2025. CMS says it will be issuing an MLN article very soon with the formal announcement.

AHCA/NCAL had been advocating for relief on these extensive new reporting requirements since they were announced. As of mid-March, less than 20 percent of SNF providers had submitted revalidation applications, risking Medicare enrollment suspension or revocation for thousands of providers. We appreciate that our recent conversations with the administration yielded this helpful outcome for providers. AHCA/NCAL will continue to push for further relief ahead of August 1st.

Additionally, CMS recently updated its [sub-regulatory guidance](#) on this issue. This most recent update, the first since December 2024, adds information related to Section (IV)(B)(2) concerning therapy and other types of services. It also adds the new FAQ #18 regarding ADPs.

The data are based on quality assessment data submitted by SNFs to Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) from **Quarter 3, 2023 through Quarter 2, 2024**. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) measures reflect data from **Quarter 4, 2023 through Quarter 1, 2024** for the Influenza Vaccination Coverage Among Healthcare Personnel measure, and **Quarter 2, 2024** for the COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage among Healthcare Personnel (HCP) measure. Claims-based measures display data from **Quarter 4, 2021 through Quarter 3, 2023**, and the SNF Healthcare-Associated Infections (HAI) Requiring Hospitalization measure data is from **Quarter 4, 2022 through Quarter 3, 2023**.
