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## More Provider Types are Now Available in the Acute and Continuing Care (ACC) Survey and Certification (S&C) Dashboard

The ACC S&C Dashboard has been enhanced to provide users access to more provider types in a centralized location. Users can quickly access S&C data supporting the following provider types:

- Ambulatory Surgical Centers (ASC)
- CLIA Laboratories
- Community Mental Health Centers (CMHC) <https://qtso.cms.gov/software/iqies/reference-manuals>
- Comprehensive Outpatient Rehab Facilities (CORF)
- Dialysis Facilities (ESRD)
- Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC)

- Home Health Agencies (HHA)
- Hospices
- Hospitals
- Intermediate Care Facilities for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities (ICF/IID)
- Outpatient Physical Therapy/Speech Pathology (OPT)
- Portable X-ray Suppliers
- Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facilities (PRTF)
- Rural Health Clinics (RHC)

The ACC S&C dashboard uses two data sources. Data for provider types that have been migrated into iQIES (HHA, ASC and Hospice) are sourced from iQIES and are updated daily. Non-migrated provider types are sourced from QIES (ASPEN) and are updated weekly. Each tab in the dashboard contains interactive graphs and charts related to provider S&C information, survey details, and much more. The data can be downloaded into a Comma Separated Value (CSV) or Excel file, if desired. To access the dashboard, log into iQIES using your HARP credentials, select the Dashboard menu option and start exploring the dashboard today.
