Bistate exercise to help community-based organizations prepare and respond to armed violent incidents

Operation Stronghold takes place April 17 | Register today!

Join us Thursday, April 17, for the **2025 Bistate Community-Based Organizations Virtual Tabletop Exercise - Operation Stronghold**. Co-hosted by the Regional Homeland Security Coordinating Committee, the Community Disaster Resiliency Network, the Metropolitan Emergency Managers Committee and the MARC Health Care Coalition, this free exercise will help community-based, faith-based and health care organizations enhance their emergency preparedness and response capabilities to activate plans, protocols and procedures during an armed violent incident.

Key concepts:

- **Threat Identification and Prevention** – What plans, policies, protocols and procedures does your organization have in place to prevent and mitigate a significant workplace violent incident at your facility?
- **Plan Activation and Individual Response** – Does your emergency plan and staff training address the necessary steps to respond to an armed violent intruder?
- **Reunification and Recovery** – How do you handle reunification of those you serve following a violent incident? What processes and resources do you have in place to assist in recovery?

Who should attend?

The target audience for this exercise includes representatives from adult day and assisted living facilities, childcare facilities, dialysis centers, emergency management agencies, federally qualified health centers, group homes, home care and hospice organizations, hospitals, long-term care facilities, organizations serving those with access and functional needs, other community organizations, places of worship, public health departments and retirement communities.
