Chef Mark Goldberg, graduated from Newbury College's Culinary Arts program (after a brief stint in Civil Engineering at Northeastern University), takes the helm of Park Restaurant & Bar in Harvard Square, bringing with him a wealth of experience and a playful spirit that shows on his menus.

Goldberg comes to Park after 7 years at Mistral, the revered French bistro in Boston's Back Bay. As Sous Chef, Goldberg worked side-by-side with noted chef/co-owner Jamie Mammano and nightlife impresario Seth Greenberg, a co-owner. In 2007, he became the Executive Chef at the seasonal Winnetu Oceanside Resort & Lure Restaurant on Martha's Vineyard for two summers.

Goldberg's modern, farm-to-table interpretations of classic New England fare earned raves from *Food & Wine*, *Cooking Light*, *Boston Magazine*, *Boston Herald* and more.

As Executive Chef of Park, Goldberg has created a menu that emphasizes playful interpretations of homey classics.
