

## CSS MITZVAH DAY Sunday June 7, 2020

**1. Packaging thousands of meals for South Shore residents** We have raised \$3,000; but the packaging is taking place at The Outreach Program's warehouse. **We will NOT be able to do it ourselves this year!** Donate to social action at [www.shaaray.org](http://www.shaaray.org) and we can sponsor more meals.

### 2. Bringing potted flowers to members of the congregation

Pick up one plant and a card at CSS from 9 to 11 AM and deliver on behalf of the congregation (wearing a mask, of course!)

### 3. Gardening and clean up

Clean up grounds and Sukkah area at CSS from 9 to 11 AM. We will wear masks and gloves and stay apart as we work! No more than 7 can sign up.

### 4. Clean up your own neighborhood

Go for a walk and pick up some trash (wearing gloves and masks, of course!)

### 5. Creating cards or little gifts

Drop off cards and little gifts at CSS from 9 to 11 AM that your kids have made **at home**. We will mail to congregants or deliver to a nursing home.

### 6. Knitting blankets

Zoom knitting group will knit squares at home that will be a part of the lovely blankets CSS gives to congregants who are recuperating from illness. ### 7. Collection for food pantries
