You should have received your 2019 tax filing documents by now. Here is a handy checklist for you to review:

- Original W-2 forms from your employer.
- If you are self-employed, all 1099-MISC forms received.
- If you are retired, the year-end statement from Social Security.
- Form 1099-R received from pension income or IRA/Annuity distributions
- 1099 Interest and Dividend Income forms from your bank or brokerage.
- 1098 Mortgage Interest paid statement.
- Property taxes paid, if not shown on form 1098.
- A list of 2019 charitable contributions.
- If claiming a childcare credit, the address and SSN of the day care provider.
- Social security numbers for all **new** dependents.
- The amount paid for college tuition for you or your dependents, Form 1098-T.
- Form 1095. You will get this from your health insurance provider. This is
- Important if you had an interruption in coverage.
- If I did not prepare your previous tax return, please provide a copy.
