From the Pastor's Desk



The year before coming to Trinity, Sherry and I had the opportunity to visit and tour Israel. The pictures you see below are taken in Bethlehem at the Church of the Nativity. Each year around Christmas I look back over the pictures I took on that trip and reflect on how special it was to be near the place where Jesus was born.

This coming October, I along with my seminary roommate Dr. Kirk McCormick, will be leading a trip to Israel. The dates will be from October 23 to November 3rd 2023. We will have the opportunity to visit sites like, Mt. Carmel where Elijah encountered the prophets of Baal, Capernaum (Jesus' home base during his ministry years), Mt of the Beatitudes, the Jordan where Jesus was baptized, the Dead Sea, the Mount of Olives, and the City of David, and we will celebrate communion at the Garden Tomb. These are just a few of the many things we will experience. We have worked hard at keeping the costs down. Our hope is to take 25 passengers at a per person rate of \$2,949. The rate includes, all hotels and all breakfasts and dinners at the hotels. The rate does not include air-fare but we are hoping it ranges between \$1,350-\$1,500. There is a flyer and study guide packet in the church office.

Financial Report - October 2022

For the month ending 10/31/2022:

- Total Income for October was \$70,066.
 - Total expenses were \$44,863.
- There was a positive operating result in October of \$25,213.

For the ten months ending 10/31/2022:

• Contributions:

Contributions over budget by \$20,479.
(due to prepayment of pledges and gifts from new givers).

• Expenses:

- Missions under budget by \$5,645 (paid quarterly)
- Finance over budget by \$2,786 (annual insurance paid in full).
 - HR under budget by \$11,058
- Total Expenses under budget by \$22,314 for the ten month period.


Ed Vasquez Painting


