From the Pastor's Desk



During the month of February, the season of Lent begins. It starts on Ash Wednesday 02/22/23 and concludes on Thursday 04/06/23. The season of Lent gives us an opportunity to reflect on God's graciousness. As we seek to please God, it is not about what we do – or refrain from doing – but it is all about accepting His gracious offer of forgiveness, made possible through Christ's blood that was shed on the cross.

Salvation is God's work, not our work. *"For by grace you have been saved"* (Ephesians 2:8a) Our salvation begins with Jesus – not us. Salvation is provided for us wholly because of His grace, His unmerited favor toward you and me. Our heavenly Father did not send His only Son to die for our sins because we kept begging and pleading for Him to do so. It was by His grace alone.

Salvation is God's work in God's way, not our way. It is *"through faith... not of yourselves; it is the gift of God."* (Ephesians 2:8b). No amount of doing good deeds or abstaining from certain pleasures can earn God's favor. Salvation is wholly by grace, through faith in Christ Jesus. It is God's gift to us.

Our focus today, as well as everyday, should be on God's goodness, His grace, and His abundant love.




