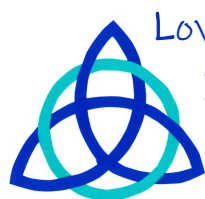

From the Pastor's Desk



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

From September through November, the various ministry committees at Trinity submit their budgets for the upcoming year. Once submitted, the Session prays, discusses, prays, reworks, prays, amends, prays, and then makes the final adjustments before praying again. After much discernment (and did I mention prayer?) they vote on the budget. Though every year brings with it new demands as well as opportunities, this year in particular, is certainly challenging.

I understand that the increase in the cost-of-living, accompanied with our declining economy, may cause some to think twice before increasing their giving to Trinity. But I also believe that it doesn't have to be that way. In fact, a situation like this can help us as a church to grow closer to God as we step out in faith.

We must not forget that God created all we see, and all we don't see, out of nothing but His word. We also know that God sent Moses, a wanted fugitive, to rescue His people from their captivity in Egypt. God in His graciousness provided food and water for them each and every day for 40 years while they wandered in the desert. Later in biblical history, God used a small boy (David) to defeat a large Giant (Goliath). In the New Testament, God answered Mary and Martha's prayer by raising their brother Lazarus from the dead. He healed those with leprosy, as well as gave sight to the blind. The greatest miracle of all came three days after being placed in a tomb; God raised Jesus from the dead. "Do I hear an Amen!?"

Each of these situations seemed insurmountable at the time, but God provided. And I truly believe that God will continue to be faithful and provide what is needed for us to meet the rising costs the new fiscal year brings.

As you will eventually see when the budget is approved, the majority of the increase in the budget lies in the area of personnel. We don't want to penalize the staff for their hard work by not helping them to keep up with inflation, as well. We have a great support staff here at Trinity, and our desire is to do our best at keeping them whole. There are, of course, many other cost increases, but our staff is a priority!

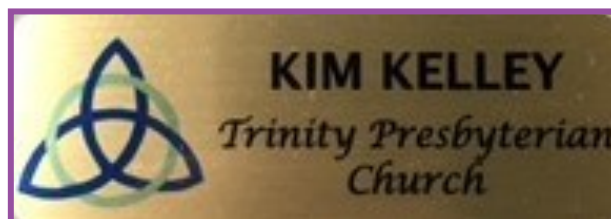

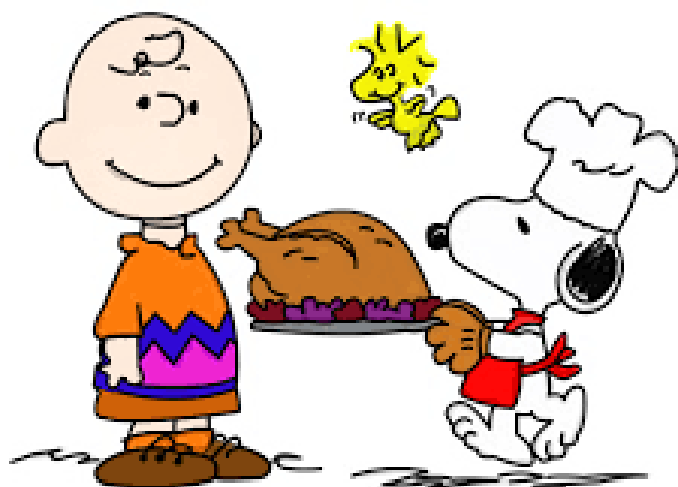

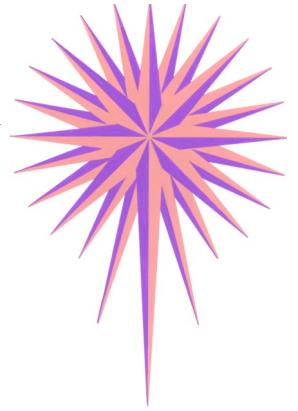
