Don't hide your talents! Bring your skills to the Party! Make a difference! Our active Lee County Democratic Party has some needs for people who've learned how to research, organize, communicate, coordinate, and collaborate. Here are just a few volunteer opportunities available:

Social Media Dashboard Admin: Oversee the timing and messaging of posts according to the Party's agenda on Lee Dems Social media platforms, periodically contribute to content creation, and collaborate with contributors.

Podcast Producer: Create weekly video content from the Party's talking points to be informative and engaging to listeners.

Legislative Action Coordinator: Collaborate with a team to draft bills on behalf of Lee County and work with our representatives to get them passed.

Voter Protection Coordinator: Work with a team to supervise and organize efforts to:

- Monitor polling place activities and ballot counting
- Staff early voting locations and Election Day polling places with trained poll watchers
- Staff early voting locations and Election Day polling places with trained poll greeters who pass out voter guides outside the polls
- Arrange for trained volunteers to attend Canvassing Board meetings
- Recruit and train volunteers to phonebank, email and knock on doors of voters who have ballots rejected because of address changes, missing signatures or mismatched signatures
- Attend regular meetings of the Florida Democratic Party Voter Protection Team to coordinate activities across the state
- Staff a Boiler Room while the polls are open to monitor voter suppression.

Canvass Coordinator: Lead Canvassing volunteers

- Recruit and train launch Captains to use mini-VAN and GPS apps
- Organize volunteers into canvassing teams
- Coordinate supplies with the Literature/door-hanging coordinator
- Enlist and schedule volunteers to go door-to-door during campaigns

Opposition Research: Gather information about non-Democratic candidates and policies and relay to the communication coordinator

Voter Registration and Retention co-field coordinator: Work on a committee to schedule and train volunteers for events or pop-up sessions to educate and update voters' status.
