### WE CHRISTIANS HEAR JESUS SAY

“All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.” Matthew 28:18ff

### THE JOB FOR THE TWELVE DISCIPLES

“These twelve Jesus sent out, instructing them, “Go nowhere among the Gentiles and enter no town of the Samaritans, but go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. And proclaim as you go, saying, ‘The kingdom of heaven is at hand, Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, cast out demons.’” Matthew 10:5ff

### JESUS GAVE THE DISCIPLES AUTHORITY

“And he called to him his twelve disciples and gave them authority over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal every disease and every affliction.”

- Yes, he sent them out two by two.
- Yes, he promised to be with them always...
- BUT, He didn't expect them to do it all by themselves.

### THE HOLY SPIRIT PREPARES THE WAY

“ And whatever town or village you enter, find out who is worthy in it and stay there until you depart. As you enter the house, greet it. And if the house is worthy, let your peace come upon it, but if it is not worthy, let your peace return to you. And if anyone will not receive you or listen to your words, shake off the dust from your feet when you leave that house or town” Matthew 10:11ff
