Earlier today, Wisconsin Governor Tony Evers extended the “Safer At Home” order to May 26, 2020, which can be found [here](#). Specific to K-12 education, the order states:

“Public and private K-12 schools will remain closed for the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year.”

This means the Hartford Union High School District remains closed and will continue with virtual learning for the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year.

Students are expected to engage with their teachers regularly and complete tasks and assignments digitally. Please watch for future communication regarding any adjustments we will be making with virtual learning for the remainder of the school year, scheduled events during the closure, and plans for students to access any personal items they may still have at school.

All HUHS activities have been canceled or postponed at this time. All building use/rentals are canceled for the remainder of the school year. The WIAA will provide more information regarding spring sports seasons and summertime regulations after their April 21st Board of Control meeting.
