Senior Photo Deadlines

Senior Photo Requirements

- Senior pictures are **due November 1, 2018**. Photos not turned in by this deadline will result in a \$25.00 fine. Photos received after November 15, 2018 **WILL NOT** be published in the 2018-19 yearbook.
- To submit a Senior Photo, please follow this process:
 - Ensure that you are submitting a digital copy of your photo. **DO NOT** submit a screenshot of your senior picture from your photographer. The image must be at least 2x3 inches at 300dpi. Files should be .jpg or .tiff. If you cannot send a digital file, we can digitize your photo but this will reduce the quality of the original.
 - Name your file with your last name_your first name (Ex: Doe_John).

- Senior pictures in the yearbook are small, so ideally the photo should show just the head and shoulders. We want to maximize your face size! Photos must be vertical color prints that meet the following requirements:
 - No pets
 - No hats
 - Simple background
 - School appropriate clothing
- Many local photographers have these deadlines and may send the photo for you if you ask. Please understand that your photographer will need probably 6 weeks or more to get photos done. This means you should have your pictures taken by the middle of September to get them done with enough time to spare.
- We cannot accept prints from a Laser or inkjet home computer printer.

Any students who do not turn in senior pictures prior to the deadline will have their HUHS school picture published in the yearbook.

Senior Meeting Jan. 9:

Wednesday, January 9, 2019 will be the date for the Class of 2019 Photo (Empire) and the distribution of Jostens Cap & Gown order forms. The meeting will be during Resource/Homeroom in the Field House.

Senior Speeches March 22:

The speeches will be reviewed by the Administration and you will be notified if your speech was selected to be presented at the graduation ceremony.

Cap & Gown Distribution Apr. 16:

Jostens will be distributing the Graduation Cap & Gown orders during the lunch periods (10:45AM - 12:15 PM). Please bring balance owed (if applicable). If you are unable to pick the order at this time, the orders will be in the main office.

Senior Survey Apr. 26:

Seniors are required to take a brief survey prior to Graduation about their post-graduation plans. The survey will be emailed to Seniors in Spring. Tickets for Graduation will not be distributed until the survey has been completed.

Yearbook Senior Parent Ads TBD:

Yearbook baby ads are an optional addition to the yearbook and are separate from the Childhood Photo for the Graduation Slide Show. Cost for yearbook baby ads is \$35 and more information will be sent out in January/February.

Graduation Tickets May 9:

Graduation tickets for the ceremony will be available in the main office (During resource, flex and before or after school). Graduates must present an ID before tickets can be issued. Only the graduate may pick up their tickets. Each graduate will receive tickets for the graduation ceremony and the graduate does not required a ticket for the ceremony. Number of tickets for each graduate will be determined at a later date.

10:45 am (Tentative time frame) Graduation Practice will be held in the Field House. Attendance is mandatory.

Graduation June 9:

1:00 PM - Hartford Union High School 2019 Graduates report to the Small Gym for pre-ceremony line-up. 1:00 PM - The HUHS Field House doors will open for admission into the Graduation Ceremony and a ticket is required to attend the ceremony. 2:00 - 3:30 PM - The Hartford Union High School "Class of 2019" Graduation Ceremony will commence.
