2019 Intramural Basketball Rules



1. Team members cannot be out for a winter sport and must be eligible according to the Co-Curricular Code of Conduct.
2. All teams will have at least 8 players and a maximum of 12 players.
3. All team members present, must play in the game.
4. Each team must have at least 5 members present at the start of the game or the team will forfeit.
5. All games will start on time. If your team is late, your team will forfeit.
6. Each team will have a shirt color for their team, to be determined before the league starts.
7. Each team must have a team captain.
8. **All players must wear proper basketball gear.** No flannel shirts, jeans, bandanas, etc. Anyone warming up or playing with any type of jewelry will not be allowed to play in that game.
9. Locker rooms will NOT be available for use, so please come dressed and ready for the games.
10. Any horseplay in or around the gym will not be tolerated and will result in that player being removed from the league.
11. Teams cannot add to the roster after the season starts, except to replace a team member that is no longer able to play and only then with a statement signed by each of the other team captains in the league and signed by Mr. Helms, Athletics and Activities director
12. **Play will be two 15 minute periods, running clock.** The clock will not stop except for injury. No timeouts will be granted on either team. Free throws will not be shot during the game and substitutions can only be made during a dead ball situation. There will be a 5 minute break between periods.
13. Five fouls and you are out of the game.
14. Except to start the game, jump balls will be handled by using the alternate possession rule.
15. Each team must provide a scorekeeper to make sure the score and fouls are kept correctly. **Only one scorekeeper per team.**
16. In the event of a tie at the end of regulation play, the winner will be determined by a sudden death free throw contest.
17. Warm up will be allowed only five minutes prior to the start of each game. Teams are not allowed to be on the court until it is your team's turn to play.
18. Swearing will not be tolerated.
 - First Time—participant is removed from the game
 - Second Time—participant is removed from the game and the following week's game
 - Third Time—participant is removed from intramural basketball
