

SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL LEARNING IN AFTERSCHOOL COHORT 2021-2022

At the heart of our field is the need to build positive relationships, create quality learning opportunities, and contribute to lifelong thriving outcomes for our youth. The profound way these values are connected within the field of SEL is the core of the ACROSS NH Social and Emotional Learning in Afterschool Cohort.

First, we will lay a foundation for understanding SEL in the context of afterschool. Each month we will provide a deep dive into specific topics connected to the implementation of SEL in afterschool programs. The specific skills of SEL will be outlined. We will examine the elements that make SEL thrive in an afterschool setting. Participation in the cohort will include a monthly 3-hour virtual work session and a post-meeting implementation assignment. Each program will have access to an ACROSS NH consultant to support the completion of SEL implementation assignments.
